You may or may not need an actual permit for your installation, and this is left as the sole responsibility of the homeowner. ***It is our strong recommendation that you acquire your permit prior to purchase.*** However, panel thickness, beam placements, beam size, distance between posts out front... all are a function of the load (**snow & wind**) that your cover will be subject to. Even though you may not require a permit, you will still need to contact them to get your local building code requirements so that we can supply you with the 'correct' materials!

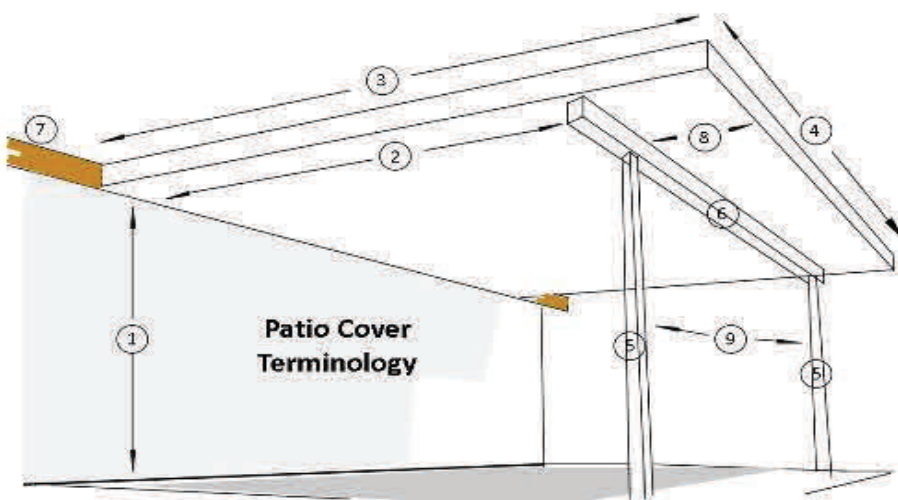
